I hope to see many of you at the August meeting.

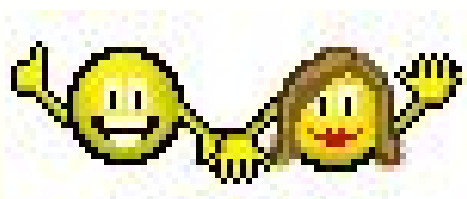


Fishing News

I-LYA Bay Week Power Boat Regatta

The I-LYA Bay Week Power Boat Regatta starts Wednesday, July 29 - Saturday, August 2. The best performer in the **four tests of seamanship**: boat handling and overall knowledge ; predicted log races; docking; and chicane (maneuvering a sequence of tight serpentine curves) – and additionally, weather prediction is awarded the Commodore's Trophy. The winner receives the "Don't Give Up The Ship" pin, and has his/her name engraved on a perpetual trophy that is displayed at the Maritime Museum in Vermillion, Ohio.

New this year will be the addition of a cardboard boat contest. Gone are the popular men's and womens' canoe races. Bob Smith and Sam Mazzola are eager for your help in building the BCBC entry...a cardboard BEAVER canoe with outriggers...to enter the Guppy Class powered by two strong BCBC members. They want you help to construct, paint and decorate the boat and to choose the two best people for "beavermotion" on Friday, July 30th.

The rules for the cardboard races and the inflatable races have been modified and can be found at i-lya.com/power.

The action continues with a Flying Mile Contest (timed by radar gun in a 500' area), Junior Navigation Contest, Inflatable Raft Races, Miniature Golf Outing, Kids Fishing Derby, Softball Game and Golf Scrambles. An adult party, sponsored by Captain Morgan Rum, is also a welcome favorite on the social events list.

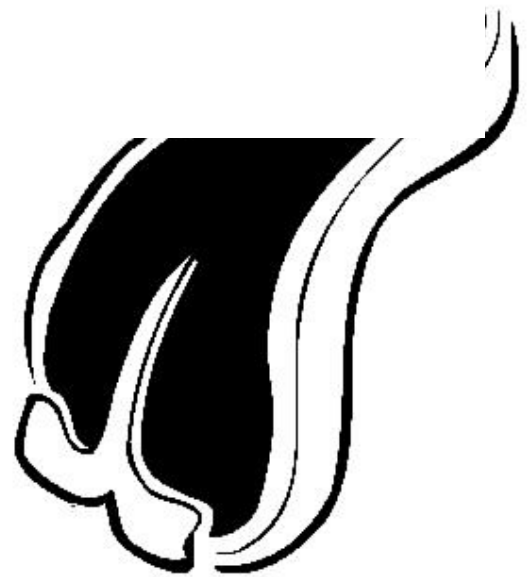

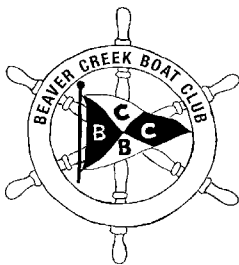
