Hope to see everyone at the Commodore's Ball .

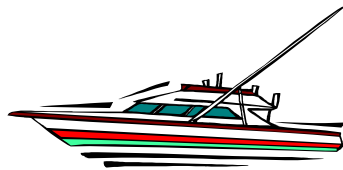
